ProgenaBiome has been making massive strides in the microbiome field, can you tell us more about your latest work?

SH: In collaboration with leading physicians in multiple specialties, Progenabiome is spearheading the microbiome research movement by validating, verifying, and clinically applying its sequencing data, to better understand the microbiome. Through our research, we are exploring new treatment options for various diseases, including Autism, Alzheimer's, Cancer, Crohn's, and more.

We currently have **33 clinical trials** examining the role of the microbiome in various conditions, and the potential healing power of the gut flora:
